

Speakers:

<u>Dr. Jerrold Atlas</u> is the retired Vice-President of the International University of Altdorf (Germany), retired Senior Professor of History, several times past President of the International Psychohistorical Association and its International Vice President. He is the Director of the Center for Psychohistorical Studies and Founding Editor of Tapestry. He is the author of numerous publications and maintains a private practice in hypnotherapy.

<u>Samuel Martin</u> was born in England and raised in an environment of high level Biblical scholarship. He spent 5 summers as a child in Israel as his father worked on an archeological excavation in Jerusalem (where he resides today). He holds a B.A. degree with a focus on Middle Eastern studies from Portland State University. His areas of concentration are social studies, Hebrew studies and science as related to the Bible. In 2006, he published his first book entitled, "Thy Rod and Thy Staff They Comfort Me: Christians and the Spanking Controversy".

Keynote Speaker: <u>Dr. Murray A. Straus</u> is a Professor of Sociology and the Co-Director of the Family Research Laboratory at the University of New Hampshire. Awarded countless grants, he has authored over 200 publications which comprise some of the most highly referenced works in the area of families and violence. Dr. Straus' book publications include the classics; "Beating the Devil Out of Them" and "Intimate Violence." He has been the recipient of many awards for his research and scholarship.

Coordinator: <u>Dr. Madeleine Y. Gomez</u> is the President of PsycHealth, Ltd. and organizer of the conference.
